

1992: A photo of this yew appears in Baxter's *The Eternal Yew*.

I visited in 2000 to find a most fragile looking tree (right) consisting of two completely detached pieces, one of which is dead. It measured only 10' 10" at 3' and did not give the impression that these were fragments of a once enormous tree.

When the dead section finally succumbs the remaining fragment will for a long time look rather forlorn. Foliage on the living part of this female yew was not the usual deep green and there were many yellow needles.
