The 'venerable yew' mentioned here by Horsfall-Turner (1903) still stands, a male tree 540cm girth and 13m tall in 1993, 530cm girth 17' 5" (at soil level) and 16m tall in 2006, on a mound SE of the church, along with a much smaller one NW of the church. Arthur O.Chater

2014: The tree is carried upwards on two large vertical stems to one side of the bole. Many large stems on the other side have been removed. Low growth prevented measurement.
