

The churchyard has many evergreen trees including at least 6 yews.

Yew 1 grows close to the churchyard wall. Girth was 2.3m at ground level, 2.9m at 1m and 2.6m at the cut branch, 40cm above ground level.





Yew 2 (right) is the largest in the churchyard. Girth at ground level was 3.7m.


Yews 3, 4 and 5 are in a row from the church close to grave stones, Yew 3, below right was about 3.1m in girth. Yew 4 is below left.





Yew 5 (below): Girth at ground level 3.4m. There are four gravestones next to this tree bearing dates from 1777 to the early years of the nineteenth century.
