

2015: Two yews grow on the south side. Tree 1, seen below, has suffered a major loss. This has been replaced at a height of 6'7" with three main branches. A girth of 15' 4" was recorded keeping the tape at about 1' above the sloping ground.

The younger yew (2) appears solid, but removing some of the ivy showed that it is beginning to hollow. Eventually it is likely to develop the horse shoe hollow shape. A girth of 13' 4" was recorded 1' above the higher ground with a horizontal tape.
