

The grade II listed church is on the A44 a few miles outside Leominster. Three yews were recorded.

A male yew, west of the church. Impossible to measure due to much upright twiggy growth low on the bole, but appeared in the 14'/16' range. There is a small platform to one side from which emerges its thickest branch. Many tall upright branches.





A male yew SE, perhaps between 12' and 14' in girth. A sturdy tree with thick branches and features, including white wood structures, suggesting great age.
