1999 - Tim Hills: The male yew with a hollow shell grows SE of the church. Two substantial elder trees compete for nutrients and should be removed. A large portion of dead sapwood (A) rises to about 14' and when this eventually falls away it will leave a horse shoe shaped tree. Girth was 17' 4" at the ground.

2015 - Paul Wood: A girth of exactly 18' was recorded at the ground. A branch at the back of the tree had reached the ground and was taking root.
