

1998: All Saints is a former estate church built in the grounds of the Kinsham Court.

The yew grows SE of the small church. Much of its bole was decaying and all that remained of substance was the large hollow branch (A) which leans towards the church. Old internal stems had decayed, as has the branch at (B) which leans away from the church. From this decaying material new smaller branches have developed (C and D). Girth: 21' 2" at its narrowest waist close to the ground.



The following photos, taken by Paul Wood in 2015, allow us to see more detail of the old bole as well as the considerable development of its remaining branches.
