

2004: The yew grows NE of the church. It was unfortunately the hiding place for an oil tank as well as a pile of drying grasses. A recent stem joined to the bole near the ground carried no pollen sacs, while on the rest of the tree pollen production was prolific. I found no signs of hollow spaces in the tree.
