

SEAVINGTON ST MARY

Date visited - 17.9.24

Height - ~ 9m

Health - average / slightly stressed judging from foliage density/size/extension growth.

Stem girth - 595cm @ 0.75m from ground level.





Description: Single stem that tri/quadrifurcates from ~ 2m. Die back of crown on church / west side.

Unidentified fruiting body of fungi on ground beside east side of stem.

Small hole cavity on east side @ ~ 1m ht.


Historic poor pruning practice.

Unusual deep rippling of stem wood.

Sex: female, berries present.

Appears unmanaged - would benefit from mulch & management of competing trees.





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
