

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE - churchyard sites with younger yews

WOTTON UNDERWOOD All Saints SP688159

Wootton Underwood has in the past been known as Wotton Ham. In the 1862 *History and Topography of Buckinghamshire* by James Joseph Sheahan “three large yew trees in the churchyard” at Wotton Ham are described. Two are seen here in the Google Earth image (2026). Their size is not known.



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
