

GLAMORGAN - churchyard sites with younger yews

PENLLYN St John the Evangelist SS97377610 16/3/2015

A yew at the east end has been swallowed up in the bushes of an adjacent garden. It appeared to be 6'8' in girth.

YSTRADOWEN St Owain ST0113477661 23/11/2021

A new church (1860) built on the site of a medieval church, next to a tumulus, called Druids Grove on 6" O/S map. The yew, which grows at the east end, has a big root base which funnels into a twin trunked yew at a height of about 6 feet. Girth of 10' 9" (328cm) was recorded just above the roots. Should we assume its planting was around the time of the new church, or is it older?
